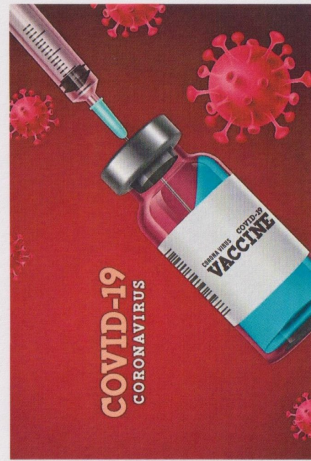

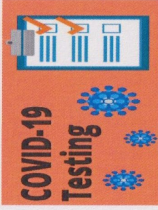

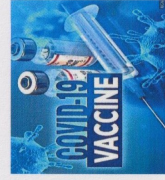

- Most major insurances - Yearly Preventive Screenings are covered under most insurances, however, verify your coverage prior to your appointment to assure the Mammovan is an accepted provider.
- Individuals NOT COVERED by health insurance may qualify for a "no charge" screening.

# Running With Kutoven Stevens

It was another great year of running in 2019. Ku is in pursuit of a dream. He works very hard at improving his running times and only gets faster with each competition. In 2019 Ku ran for YHS track as a freshman and cross-country as a sophomore. Following his freshman cross-country season he participated in Coach Phillip Kruze's off season running program in preparation for track season. The winter running paid off with Ku finishing the season at State in Las Vegas with a 4:43 1600 meter run (1 mile run).

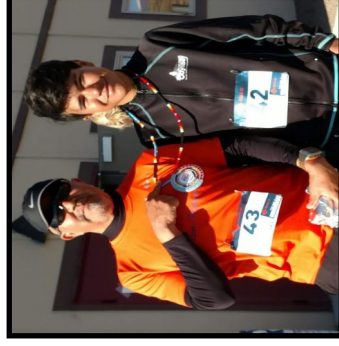

- March 30 – Giant run in Sacramento\* 5K 3<sup>rd</sup> overall 1,605 runners, 1<sup>st</sup> in age
- April 6 – Reno river run\* 5K 1<sup>st</sup> overall 298 runners
- April 13 – Kaia fit "run the rez" in Wadsworth\* 5K 1<sup>st</sup> overall
- April 21 – WRPT Easter run in Schurz\* 5K 1<sup>st</sup> overall
- May 31 – June 1 Reno Tahoe Odyssey\* 178 miles; finished 107 in 28 hrs. 27 seconds
- June 29 – Sacred visions powwow run in Wadsworth\* 4 miles 1<sup>st</sup> overall
- July 20 – Rez challenge in Schurz\* 16-mile relay, 1<sup>st</sup> team
- September 7 – Reno mile 1 mile 5<sup>th</sup> overall, 100 runners, 1<sup>st</sup> in age
- September 8 – Journal jog in Reno\* 8K 8<sup>th</sup> overall, 450 runners, 2<sup>nd</sup> in age
- September 21 – WRPT Pinenut festival in Schurz\* 5K 1<sup>st</sup> overall
- December 8 – WRPT Jingle bell run in Schurz\* 5K 1<sup>st</sup> overall, 6<sup>th</sup> year in a row

The \* means that it was a father and a son running in the same event and sharing in the love of running. I am immensely grateful for this ability that was given to us Stevens runners. To feel the breeze in our faces, to lace up the running shoes, to enjoy that goodness that the creator allowed us to feel, to be together as a father and son and to be truly blessed.

**Reno Tahoe Odyssey RTO** - Our team sponsored by the Walker River Paiute Tribe and known as "Runweiser" finished again in a respectable time and most importantly ahead of the RSIC team "All my relay-tions". Ku won't be running with us this year because he was recruited by an elite team of young fast runners. They should finish way ahead of Team Runweiser.



**As a freshman Ku ran track.** Spring track season was chilly, but Ku and his team powered through the cold. Ku's events are the 800 meter, 1600 meter, 3200 meter and the 4X800 relay. As a freshman he had a fantastic season. He competed in 8 separate competitions earning 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in these competitions. At State in Las Vegas his 4X800 team took 2nd, in the 1600 he placed 5th with a PR of 4:43, and 3rd in the 3200. Ku is the **fastest freshman in the state of Nevada** across all divisions in the mile. His efforts earned him the **Iron Man Award** for YHS. This is the most prestigious award for YHS track and he earned it as a freshman.

**As a sophomore Ku ran cross country** and competed in 9 competitions. He earned first places in Gardnerville, the Twilight Classic in Reno, Winnemucca and Silver Stage. He earned a 3rd place finish in Regionals and at State.

The **Peace and Dignity Journey** is every 4 years and this is the year that the run will honor the fire. This run is a prayer to unite the North and the South and to promote our continued survival and commitment to a spiritual way of life. This will be his third time offering prayers in this sacred run.

Ku still supports and represents the **Reno Running Company**. In the non-school related runs Ku sports the Reno Running Company shirt. There have been many first-place podium poses wearing their logo. A big shout out to **Coach Phillip Kruze** for coaching and mentoring Ku and the distance runners. Coach Kruze is a huge inspiration and showed up as a prayer being answered. Ku wants to attend the University of Oregon and run for the Ducks.

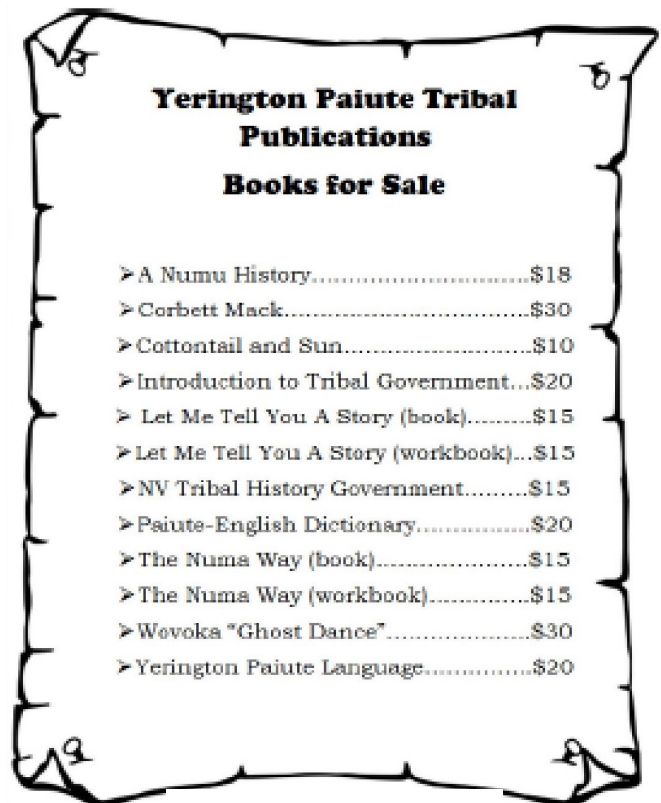

Native Youth Community Project (NYCP) seeks to prepare American Indian (AI) students in grades 7-12 for college and careers using a three-fold plan that includes: [a] the support of a College and Career Coach (CC) and Community-Based Instructor (CBI); [b] activities designed to improve students academic performance, including, tutoring, summer programs, and conferences designed to engage students and guided visits to colleges; and [c] community collaborative events. This is year 4 for the project. COVID-19 pandemic and school closures impacted the plan in year 3, now online learning has been a struggle for the native students and students as a whole. And the pandemic is still here.

Every year the YPT Education Department staff encourage families (parents/students) to enroll in NYCP. If your student isn't enrolled, there's still time to get involved. The staff is reaching out to the native community to get students, and parents, involved in NYCP.

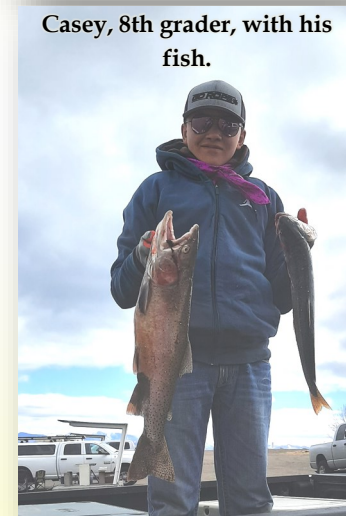
