I. PROGRAM POLICIES AND APPLICATION PROCESS

PURPOSE: The Yerington Paiute Tribe (YPT) Higher Education Grant Program provides financial assistance to enrolled members of the Yerington Paiute Tribe. Students must be entering or continuing with their post-secondary education and require financial support to achieve their higher education degrees.

BACKGROUND: The Yerington Paiute Tribe Higher Education Program is contracted through a Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA) 638 Contract. The YPT Higher Education Grant Program, administered under the authority of the Snyder Act of November 2, 1921, provides financial assistance to eligible Yerington Paiute Tribal members who have a financial need to attend college.

HIGHER EDUCATION GRANT PROGRAM APPLICATION PROCESS

- 1. **New student:** A student that is a first time applicant applying for the Yerington Paiute Tribe Higher Education Grant Program;
- 2. **Continuing student:** Student in good standing who has continuously enrolled and attended college as a fulltime student and has maintained eligibility requirements;
- 3. **Returning student:** Student who has experienced a break in attendance and is reapplying for Higher Education funding assistance;
- 4. **Graduate student:** An applicant seeking Higher Education financial assistance to attend graduate school. Applicant must verify that YPT funding is supplemented by other funding sources.

II. APPLICANT ELIGIBILITY AND GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Applicant must be an enrolled member of the Yerington Paiute Tribe;
- 2. Applicant must have a High School Diploma, Adult Diploma, or GED Certificate;
- 3. Applicant must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA);
- 4. Applicants are required to complete a minimum of 12 units and maintain a 2.0 GPA;
- 5. Applicant must submit all required paperwork and complete applications by the appropriate deadline date;
- 6. APPLICATION DEADLINES
 - a. New and Returning Students;

- 2nd Monday in July For Academic Year or Fall Semester
- 2nd Monday in December For Spring Semester
- b. Continuing Students;
 - 2nd Monday in July For Academic Year
- 7. YPT Higher Education Grant funding is limited to 10 semesters;

8. **IMPORTANT REMINDERS**:

- a. Incomplete applications will not be considered for funding;
- b. Continuing students that submit late final grades or personal update information, or incomplete applications will risk future funding;
- c. Students who fax information must do so before 4:00pm by the deadline date specified above and must verify receipt of fax with the Education Department by 4:30/ close of business day;
- d. Parents and students are encouraged to call the Education Director within 30 to 60 days prior to application deadline if they need assistance with completing the application;
- e. Deadline dates are final and will not be extended;
- f. Academic Probation: A student who does not meet the minimum academic requirement for one semester will be funded on Academic Probation status during the next semester.

*Academic Probation Requirement: Student will be required to receive a 2.0 or higher GPA on college credits equivalent to that amount that was lost resulting in being placed on academic probation.

*Notification of this action will be made to the student by letter from the Education Director; lack of notification does not negate the action. If substantial progress is not made during probationary period, the student's Tribal funding shall be suspended.

- g. Funding Suspension: Funding will be suspended if a student fails to complete a minimum of 12 credits in a semester. Future funding will not be considered until the student successfully completes the credit deficiency of the semester suspended and meets the minimum GPA of 2.0 or higher in a semester without YPT Higher Education funding and provides verification to the Education Department;
- h. Repayment of Higher Education Grant Funds: If the grant award is not used for the intended purpose, if the student withdraws from the college WITHOUT IMMEDIATE WRITTEN NOTIFICATION to the YPT Higher Education Program, and/or if the student doesn't withdraw in accordance with school policies so that a portion of the grant is returned to the YPT Higher Education Program funding will be suspended or terminated;
- i. Additional funding: Students on funding suspension and/or who have exhausted ten semesters limit of Higher Education funding are not eligible to supplement degree completion with for the YPT Enrichment funding; nor can YPT Enrichment funding support attaining a college degree.

III. GRANT APPLICATION PROCESS: NEW STUDENTS

1. APPLICATION DEADLINE DATES:

- a. Academic year or fall: 2nd Monday of July
- b. Spring: 2nd Monday of December
- 2. You are required to submit a copy of your Yerington Paiute Tribe enrollment card / certification;
- You are required to submit a copy of your letter of acceptance to an accredited educational institution or a letter from Admissions and Records;
- 4. You are required to submit a copy of your high school diploma, adult education diploma, or GED Certificate;

- 5. You are required to complete and submit Application Form 1, Certificate of Release Form 3, and Certificate of Compliance Form 4. Forms 3 and 4 must be notarized;
- 6. You are required to submit confirmation that you have completed the FAFSA application process along with your application;
- 7. You are required to complete the top half of the Financial Needs Analysis Form 2 and submit to your college/university financial aid office;
- You are required to submit a copy of your semester class schedule to the YPT Education Department 8. before funding is released;
- You are required to submit a copy of your final grades to YPT Education Department within 10 days after 9. the last day of class for the semester funded;
- 10. You are required to submit your Official Grade Transcripts from Admissions and Records to the YPT Education Department within 30-days after the end of the semester funded;
- You are required to submit to the YPT Education Department your contact information on Form 5 while 11. attending school along with your application and notify the department within 10 days if there is a change in your contact information using the same form.

IV. GRANT APPLICATION PROCESS: CONTINUING STUDENTS

As a continuing student you are not required to complete a full application however, if you transfer to 1. another college/university you must complete a full grant application:

APPLICATION DEADLINE DATES: 2.

- a. Academic year: 2nd Monday in July
- 3. You are required to maintain at least a 2.0 GPA each semester and successfully complete a minimum of 12 credits per semester;
- You are required to submit a copy of your final grades for the fall semester to YPT Education Department 4. within 10 days after the last day of class;
- You are required to submit a copy of your semester class schedule to the YPT Education Department 5. before funding is released;
- 6. You are required to submit Application Form 1, FAFSA confirmation, Official Transcripts from Admissions and Records to the YPT Education Department by the 2nd Monday in July for continuing academic year funding;
- You are required to submit to the YPT Education Director any change in your contact information on Form 7. 5 while attending school within 10 days of the change or risk funding;

V. GRANT APPLICATION PROCESS: RETURNING STUDENTS AND GRADUATE STUDENTS

APPLICATION DEADLINE DATES: 1.

- a. Academic year or fall: 2nd Monday of July
 b. Spring: 2nd Monday of December

- 2. You are required to submit a copy of your letter of acceptance to the accredited educational institution or a letter from Admissions and Records;
- 3. You are required to submit your Official Transcripts from the last school and semester attended;
- 4. You are required to complete and submit Application Form 1, Certificate of Release Form 3, and Certificate of Compliance Form 4. Forms 3 and 4 must be notarized;
- 5. You are required to submit confirmation that you have completed the FAFSA application process along with your application;
- 6. You are required to complete the top half of the Financial Needs Analysis Form 2 and submit to your college/university financial aid office;
- 7. You are required to submit a copy of your semester class schedule to the YPT Education Department before funding is released;
- 8. You are required to submit a copy of your final grades to YPT Education Department within 10 days after the last day of class of the semester funded;
- 9. You are required to submit your Official Grade Transcripts from Admissions and Records to the YPT Education Department within 30-days after the end of the semester funded;
- 10. You are required to submit to the YPT Education Department your contact information on Form 5 while attending school along with your application and notify the department within 10 days if there is a change in your contact information using the same form.

VI. CALCULATION OF AWARD

The calculation process of the award for applicants is based on a Financial Needs Analysis (FNA) and the unmet need.

The college Financial Aid Officer (FAO) completes the Tribe's FNA form. The Education Director follows the Tribal Higher Education Program Policies and Application Process to determine the Unmet Need based on the FAO's input. The student is awarded up to three thousand dollars (\$3,000) of their unmet need. Tribal allocation is a maximum of three thousand dollars (\$3,000) per semester. Adjustments may be made to the calculated student award based on the available yearly budget. Adjustment will be made across the board in a fair and equitable manner.
